

(1) A Constitution Bench of Supreme Court of India in Puttaswamy Case Civil No 494 of 2012 and connected matters, dated 26<sup>th</sup> September 2018 (hereinafter referred to as Aadhaar Judgment) declared about the prohibition on demand of Aadhaar for various matters.

Who received the copy of and directions regarding the Aadhaar Judgment, on what date it was received and where it has been uploaded at the website of Ministry or MSME and its related websites and coordinating offices including the Udyog Aadhaar website?

(2) Who has the responsibility for uploading the Aadhaar Judgment on the website of Ministry of MSME and has he or she fulfilled his legal and official duties immediately after receipt of the Aadhaar Judgment?

(3) Who is responsible for managing the duties and obligations arising out of legal provisions and Supreme Court Judgments at the Ministry of MSME?

(4) On whose authority or direction Aadhaar has been made mandatory for filling online forms for Udyog Aadhaar or MSME certificate?

(5) Who is responsible for handling offline applications for Udyog Aadhaar or MSME certificate at Ministry of MSME or its allied and associated offices?

(6) How much time is taken for issuance of an Udyog Aadhaar or MSME certificate in an offline mode as time taken for issuance of an online Aadhaar is instantaneous?

(7) We sent an application for Udyog Aadhaar or MSME certificate on 09 Jun 2019 in electronic form as per applicable laws of India, Supreme Court's Aadhaar Judgment and Indian government Digital India project and policies. It carried a scanned and duly filled and signed copy of application form along with alternative and viable documents like driving licence, PAN and pass book of bank. So the form was submitted with all necessary documents and there was nothing missing in the same. (Copy attached)

What is the responsibility of the respective individuals e-mailed by us and who among them has the official and legal duty to consider such application and issue the certificate?

(8) Who in the Ministry of MSME has the responsibility to receive legal notices, contempt notices, etc and to reply back the same?

(9) What is the status of our application for Udyog Aadhaar or MSME certificate as on date?
